Congratulations!!

This is a wonderful opportunity!

- 2 years worth of college credits - Free!!
- Free textbooks
- Finish with your high school diploma (4 years) and 60+ college credits (2 years) in only 5 years total – not 6
- Make your own college schedule
- Transfer credits to a 4-year college
- Finish bachelor's degree 1 year earlier than normal

Program Highlights

- Students remain part of home high school
- Participate in all school activities: prom, sports, band, etc. through 12th grade.
- Walk with your class in commencement ceremony at the end of 12th grade: June 2022
- Begin taking classes at Henry Ford College during 11th grade.
- No classes in the high school during the “13th year”.
- Earn normal HS diploma, 60+ college credits & associate’s degree 1 year after normal grad year: June 2023.
(if all goes well!)

Typical Course Sequence

11th Grade:

- › Semester One: COLL 101 & 5 HS classes
- › Semester Two: 2 HFC classes & 4 HS classes

12th Grade:

- › 1 HS elective class both semesters
- › Full-time HFC schedule both semesters
- › Treat this year like freshman year of college!!

13th Year:

- › Full-time college schedule at HFC all year
- › Must take senior math class for HS graduation

Tuitions and fees: \$15,948

Room and Board : \$12,034

Books: \$ 1,048

2 years: \$58,060!!

Wayne State

- Tuition and Fees: \$13,922
 - Room and Board: \$ 10,694
 - Books: \$1,246
- Total : \$25,862

2 Years: \$51,724!!

- Students apply to 4-year colleges as first-year freshman, so they are eligible for all freshman, merit-based scholarships.
- Credits transfer from HFC and students will most likely begin as juniors in college
